Six Dimensions

Describe: Students describe the topic, including its colors, shapes, and sizes.

Compare: Students compare the topic to something else, explaining how it's similar to or different from this other thing.

Associate: Students associate the topic with something else and explain why it makes them think of this other thing.

Analyze: Students analyze the topic and tell how it's made or what it's composed of.

Apply: Students apply the topic, describing how it can be used or what can be done with it.

Argue For or Against: Students take a stand and argue for or against the topic, giving reasons to support their position.
